Health & Safety

- Team of health professionals from the parish have implemented these guidelines to ensure safety

- Wear mask at all times
- Basic health assessment for everyone asks
In the last 14 days have you...
 - been diagnosed with COVID-19?
 - been exposed to anyone diagnosed with COVID-19?
 - had a cough, fever, chills, shortness of breath?

Please do not attend if you currently have a cough, fever, chills, shortness of breath, or been diagnosed with or exposed to anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days.

- Communion offered under one species
- No distribution of Precious Blood

- Receive host in the hand

Social Distancing

- Limit of 25% capacity for indoor gatherings**
- Register for masses
- Separate entrance and exit
- No choir, altar servers, or eucharistic ministers

- Keep 6' distance at all times
- No contact at sign of peace
- No gathering in groups before or after mass

Sanitization

All doors, pews, and other contact surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized after each mass

- No missalettes
- No passed collection baskets

- Do not bring personal items (books, missalettes, etc.)
- Stationary offertory collection box
