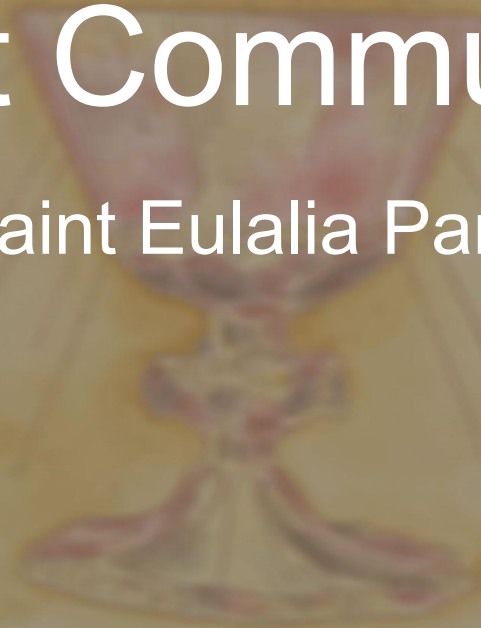




First Communion

How to Receive Communion

1. Approach Father Tudgay with your hands together, finger pointing to heaven.
 - The student receiving will have their mask off or lowered.
 - The family will approach with the student.
 - Everyone else must remain masked while receiving communion.
2. Father will hold up the host and say ***“The Body of Christ”***
3. You say ***“Amen”***
4. Place your left hand on top of your right hand and make a little bowl with your top left hand.
5. He will then place the host on your top hand.
6. Take your right hand from under your left. Pick up the host with your right hand. Place the host in your mouth.

Practice at home with goldfish crackers or grapes or smooshed up pieces of bread!





- 1: Approach with your hands together, pointing to heaven, and your mask off or lowered.
- 2: Father says *The Body of Christ*
- 3: You say *Amen*



- 3: Left hand on top of right hand
- 4: Father places the host in your top hand

- 5: Take your right hand from under your left. Pick up the host with your right hand. Place the host in your mouth.

ATTIRE
